1. Old Business
 - a. Tasks to do:
 - i. Find metropolitan areas that would be cost-effective for an NSLS Int’l Career Event
 1. Southeast – Mr. Klein

 3. Mid-Atlantic – Mr. Scheimer
 - ii. Employer/Career Info – Send to Mr. Scheimer
 1. Possible NSL Employers
 2. Job search strategy articles
 - b. Trademark – Mr. Creedon
 - i. “NSLS” is already approved; “National Security and Law Society” is not yet approved, but our attorney is handling it.
 - ii. Mr. Creedon predicts the name will be trademarked successfully, and will keep the IEC updated
 - c. Publishing Issue – Mr. Creedon
 - i. American University chapter is handling this
 - ii. Solution: Pocket part will be added to each copy with the article that was left out, and a label will be placed over the byline of the misattributed article in the main part of the book
 - d. Corporate Address – Mr. Creedon
 - i. Currently Brad Moss’ address
 - ii. Must be an address in Washington, D.C., where NSLS Int’l is incorporated
 - iii. Mr. Klein and Mr. Creedon will work on securing a new address
 - e. Logo – Mr. Creedon
 - i. Mr. Creedon proposed getting a new logo designed

 - ii. IEC unanimously approved proposal

 - c. Mr. Klein will give Mr. Bobich the email address from the coordinator of EMININT 2007
 - d. All IEC members will search for donors
